1. WORLD EXPO 2025 UPDATES

• Expo 2025 Finally Opens!

After years of build-up, Expo 2025 Osaka, Kansai, Japan finally opened

to the public on April 13, 2025-a 184-day extravaganza focusing on the

theme of "Designing Future Society for Our Lives." Come see and experience what the future's going to look
like! Day 1 featured an opening ceremony for a variety of overseas pavilions, including China, the Republic
of Korea, Indonesia, Spain, Austria, Colombia, and the Czech Republic. In attendance from the OCCI were
Chairperson Shingo Torii, Vice-Chair Junzo Tateno, and President Setsuo Iuchi.
Following this, on April 15th, 2025, the Osaka prefectural and city governments, the OCCI, and the broader
business community held an Osaka Welcome Reception for guests from 160 countries and regions around the
world. Nearly 600 people from Japan and abroad participated, providing momentum for the success of the
Expo.

AJB EXPO Symposium

 \sim Future of ASEAN-Japan Symposium a Tremendous Success \sim

To support member companies' business in ASEAN countries with its inclusive support system ASEAN Japan Business Promotion Network (AJB Network)", connecting Japanese local chambers of commerce and establishing the nationwide community in Japan.

The Future of ASEAN-Japan Special Symposium hosted by the OCCI on April 21, 2025, attracted a large inperson and online crowd of around 550 people.Following opening remarks by OCCI Chairperson Shingo Torii and video messages from government officials, the chairpersons of participating chambers of commerce and industry (Osaka, Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, and Thailand) announced the joint Statement adopted earlier by the Executive Committee. Then there was a special lecture by Kunihiko Hirabayashi, secretary general of the ASEAN-Japan Centre, followed by a keynote address by a top executive from Shopee, a Singapore-based tech company specializing in e-commerce, who spoke about his hopes that Japanese companies will harness digital technologies to expand into the ASEAN region.

The second half of the symposium featured a panel discussion, in which Michael Henssler, chief operating officer of Centara Hotels & Resorts, which operates a chain of hotels in and around Thailand, and a representative from the World Association of Overseas Japanese Entrepreneurs discussed the potential for The Osaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry business between Japan and the ASEAN region. The event was rounded off with a networking event for local and ASEAN-based enterprises.

· OCCI and HKTDC Renew MOU on Cooperation

OCCI Chairperson Shingo Torii and Hong Kong Trade Development Council(HKTDC)Executive Director Margaret Fong signed a renewed MOU on April 17, 2025, relating to mutual cooperation between the two organizations. Ms. Fong, who was in town for the World Expo, previously signed the original MOU in 2014 in her capacity as deputy executive director with the OCCI's then-chairperson, Shigetaka Sato. The parties determined to renew their agreement in light of the uptick in global attention Osaka is receiving as a result of the expo, so as to deepen the bonds of cooperation binding Osaka and Hong Kong in areas of common strength, such as healthcare, innovation and technology, and to promote inter-regional business and revitalize the economy.

4. NEWS FROM THE OSAKA ECONOMIC COMMUNITY

OCCI SME & MID-SCALE BUSINESS SENTIMENT SURVEY: SMALLER BUSINESSES EAGER TO LAUNCH NEW PRODUCTS, EXPAND INTO NEW MARKETS, HIRE FOREIGN WORKERS

An OCCI survey of SMEs and mid-scale businesses (capital up to ¥1 bil.) with offices in Osaka Prefecture regarding the state of their businesses, challenges, and cash flow (413 responses) revealed some interesting trends about the local SME business landscape.

●47.5% of respondents said sales were up year-on-year in FY2024; 27.4% reported a decrease-a difference of

more than 20 points

• The most commonly cited priority tasks were finding new clients and developing new sales channels (57.1%,

up 8.1 points from the March 2024 survey), and tackling labor shortages (45.0%).

●67.1% are eager to focus energies on launching new products and entering new markets

●42.4% want to hire foreign workers; this marks a significant increase (12.2 points) over the March 2024

survey, bringing this to around the same level as those looking for highly skilled or specialist workers and

OCCI Survey on Trump Tariffs Shows 80% of SMEs Believe They May Be Affected Survey conducted: April 10-14, 2025

Target: 1,541 OCCI member companies (capital up to ¥300 mil.)

Valid responses received: 293

An OCCI survey shows that more than 80% of SMEs believe they may be affected by the tariffs recent announced by the Trump administration. A broad array of concerns were cited, including stagnation of economic activity, financial market instability, declining orders, rollback of wage increases, and difficulty in procuring parts.
