## 2. PLANNED OVERSEAS MISSIONS BY OCCI

[OCCI, O-BIC Strengthen Ties with Manchester Through Agreements, Visits]

The OCCI has entered into a partnership agreement with MIDAS, the business and investment promotion agency of Manchester in the UK, with a view to further parlaying the two cities' friendly relations into greater business interaction. Meanwhile, Osaka City is planning a delegation to Manchester, its partner city in the UK, between September 3 and 5,

2025. As with last year, the delegation will include the executive director of the Osaka Business and Investment Center (O-BIC), who will spread the word about Osaka as an ideal investment destination for UK businesses.

The OCCI and O-BIC will team up with the Osaka Fujian Association for the third consecutive year to exhibit at the China International Fair for Investment and Trade (CFIT) from September 8 to 11, 2025. CIFIT is a world-class trade show hosted by the Chinese Ministry of Commerce.

## 3. NEWS FROM THE OSAKA ECONOMIC COMMUNITY

Survey Reveals SME Concerns About Impact of US Tariffs

The OCCI conducted an urgent survey of 1,479 SMEs in Osaka regarding the US's tariffs. The survey was conducted on July 29-30, 2025, and received 246 responses. Some 11.4% of respondents said that they had already been affected by the tariffs, up eight points from the previous survey, which was conducted in April 2025. More than 55% of respondents said may be affected in the future. When asked about the specific impacts they expect to bear (multiple choice question), 58.1% said economic and trade stagnation in Japan and worldwide, and 50% said a downturn in orders due to a decline in exports to the US by client companies.
