

Feel a tingling sensation of Osaka's design impact (feat. BILLIKEN)

The Zone name 'Futubilly' combines 'Future' and Billiken. Billiken is known as Osaka's symbolic 'GOD' to bring luck. This zone will use Billiken as a model to express Osaka's innovative materials such as synthetic leather made from rice. This will be dved using ecofriendly printing technology.

Japanese kimono fabric will be presented with modern design using traditional Japanese dying methods. This will be designed by Osaka's young students.

Concept:

Feel a new sense of world with Japan's traditional black dying method 'Kurozome' and Japan's traditional circular knitting machine.

*Black in Japanese is 'Kuro' and going round and round in Japanese is 'Kurukuru'.

The key material in this zone will be 'recycled airbags' which will be transformed into a fashionable item using the above traditional methods. This will be designed by Osaka's young students.
